East Honolulu Watershed Management Plan (EHWMP)

The EHWMP is one of eight district plans prepared by the City & County of Honolulu Board of Water Supply (BWS) and Department of Planning and Permitting. Together, the plans comprise the O'ahu Watershed Management Plan. The EHWMP is intended to be an environmentally holistic, community-based, and economically viable watershed management plan that is action oriented and incorporates ahupua'a-based management principles. The plan will identify key water resource issues and recommend policies, strategies, and projects to ensure adequate and sustainable water supply for East Honolulu for the next twenty years.
